WHAT IS AVICLEAR?

AviClear is an FDA-approved laser that treats mild to severe acne. This is a unique laser technology because of the wavelength it uses, by selectively targeting and suppressing the sebaceous glands, which produce the sebum (the oily substance on the skin) that can cause and intensify breakouts. The laser improves your acne over the course of three monthly treatments. It is safe for all skin types and tones, no matter the severity of a particular breakout. Not only does this treatment reduce existing acne, but clinical trials have shown that, following a proper course of AviClear treatments, future breakouts are less frequent, less severe and shorter overall.

HOW IT WORKS


AviClear targets the sebaceous glands that cause acne. AviClear is an acne treatment without the use of topical or oral acne medications.

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BEFORE TREATMENT

- Sun Avoidance: leading up to your treatment is important. Tanning beds, and artificial tanning may increase the risk of side effects and adverse events. We cannot treat patients who have an active sunburn or have too much recent sun exposure.
- Valtrex for history of cold sores. If you have a history of cold sores, let your cosmetic provider know. Patients should be on a preventative five-day course of an antiviral medication that starts the day before your treatment to avoid creating cold sores.
- Avoid skin irritants (i.e., products containing tretinoin, retinol, benzoyl peroxide, glycolic/salicylic acids, vitamin C/ascorbic acid, etc.) for 1 week pre and post treatment, and treatments that may irritate the skin for 1-2 weeks prior to treatment (waxing, depilaories, etc.)

AFTER TREATMENT

- Immediately, apply a broad- spectrum (UVA/UVB) SPF 30+ sunblock, which should be applied at least once daily. Cold compresses or chilled gel packs may be applied post-treatment for your comfort.
- Starting the morning after treatment, wash your face with a gentle cleanser, followed by a gentle moisturizer twice a day for a 1 week. Resume regular skincare regimen 1 week after treatment.
- Makeup can be applied the day after treatment.
- Start applying UVA/UVB 30+ SPF sunblock DAILY, starting the morning after treatment. Sunblock should be applied at least once daily, reapplying every 90-minutes if outside.
- Direct sun exposure should be minimized throughout the duration of the treatment regimen.
- Most patients will experience mild redness of the treatment area, lasting up to one day
- Dryness and itching is normal up to four weeks post-treatment. Use a gentle moisturizer.
- If a blister develops, treat it as an open sore/wound.
- Roughly half of AviClear patients may experience acne flareups after one or all their treatments. Acne may worsen before it improves. Typically occurs a 2-4 post-treatment, and can last a few weeks.
- Avoid heat (hot tubs, saunas, etc.) for 1-2 days post-treatment.
- Limit any exercise or activity that can cause sweating for 24 hours post-treatment.
- Avoid skin irritants a 1 week after treatment (tretinoin, retinol, benzoyl peroxide,
- glycolic/salicylic acids, vitamin C/ascorbic acid).
- Avoid treatments that may irritate the skin for 1-2 weeks after treatment: Waxing, depilatories, etc.

POSSIBLE SIDE EFFECTS

- Common: Redness, swelling, acne flare up, dryness
- Rare: Crusting, scabbing, blisters, hyper/hypo pigmentation, scarring
